

PUBLIC NOTICE OHQ000003  
NPDES Statewide Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) General Permit Renewal

On the basis of staff review and application of standards and regulations, on November 27, 2013, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency will issue a draft general permit renewal for the statewide regulation of Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) to discharge storm water. The draft permit will be issued as a final action unless the Director revises the draft after consideration of the record of a public hearing or written comments, or upon disapproval by the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Any person may submit comments on the draft permit and administrative record.

The general permit for Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) to discharge storm water (Permit No. OHQ000003) is the third generation of this general permit. This permit would afford coverage to all small MS4s required to obtain NPDES permit coverage to discharge throughout the State of Ohio. The permit identifies who can be covered, how an entity obtains coverage and how a permittee terminates coverage. The permit contains requirements for permittees to develop and implement a Storm Water Management Program (SWMP). The SWMP provides what best management practices (BMPs) the MS4 has selected to address the six minimum control measures in the permit, why those particular BMPs were selected by the MS4 in light of local water quality issues, and milestones for BMP implementation.

The processing of this general permit and associated Notices of Intent for coverage is and will be done, respectively, in accordance with Ohio's antidegradation rule, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-1-05, and NPDES general permit rules, OAC 3745-38.

An Ohio EPA public hearing to accept comments on the draft general permit has been scheduled for 1:30 PM on Wednesday, January 22, 2014 at the Ohio EPA, 50 West Town Street, Columbus, Ohio, Ohio EPA Conference Center Rm. A. The public hearing will end when everyone in attendance has had an opportunity to provide comments related to the draft general permit. In lieu of attending the public hearing, written comments may be submitted as outlined in the following paragraph.

Interested persons are invited to submit written comments on this general permit. Comments should be submitted in person or by mail no later than January 29, 2014.
