Dear Ms. Beringer:

On April 7, 2010, Ohio EPA received a request dated April 5, 2010, for a Class 1A (Class 1 requiring prior approval) hazardous waste permit modification from Heritage-WTI, Inc. (WTI). The modification was assigned permit information tracking system (PITS) ID number OHD 980 613 541 - #100407-1A-1. With this letter, Ohio EPA approves the above referenced class 1A modification submitted pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-51.

**FOR APPROVAL:**

The following modification has been made to your Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit. Also the records of Ohio EPA have been changed accordingly:

WTI requested the elimination of Condition B.20.(b) from the facility's Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit. Condition B.20.(b) of the Permit previously stated "the Permittee's emergency response team shall, to the extent possible, assist and advise local community response organizations in responding to transportation incidents involving hazardous waste in transit to or from the facility". Since there is no regulatory basis for this requirement, WTI requested the elimination of this condition from the permit.

Condition B.20.(b) has been modified to "Reserved". The Part B permit application is not affected.

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Changes to the Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit include:

- Replace page 26 of 117

The affected permit page is modified in the upper left corner of the page as well as modified in the text, and is date-stamped with the date of this letter from Ohio EPA.

Enclosed is a copy of the revised permit page for the WTI Part B permit application. This has been included to ensure that all involved parties have written confirmation of the change. B.19. Emergency Coordinator  
OAC Rule 3745-54-55

The Permittee shall comply with the requirements set forth in OAC Rule 3745-54-55 and the Contingency Plan, Section G, of the approved Part B permit application regarding the emergency coordinator.

B.20. Emergency Procedures  
OAC Rule 3745-54-55

- (a) The Permittee shall comply with the requirements set forth in OAC Rule 3745-54-56, all applicable sections of the approved Part B permit application, e.g., the contingency plan, Section G, and the conditions of this permit regarding the emergency procedures.
- (b) Reserved.

B.21. Availability, Retention, and Disposal of Records  
OAC Rule 3745-54-74

The Permittee shall furnish upon Ohio EPA request and retain all records at the facility in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-54-74, the approved Part B permit application, and all terms and conditions of this permit.

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
